Special Collection

The Clean Up Schedule is as follows:

Regular Collection Day	Special Collection Week
Monday	#1 June 16 th - June 20 th
Tuesday	#2 June 23 rd - June 27 th
Wednesday	#3 June 30 th , July 2 nd - 5 th
Thursday	#4 July 7 th - July 11 th
Friday	#5 July 14 th - July 18 th

What's Accepted?

White goods: refrigerators, freezers, washers & dryers, etc. Bulky items: furniture, box springs, & mattresses, etc. Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D): doors, windows, siding, carpet, & lumber.

REMINDERS

- All materials must be placed for collection by 6:30 a.m. on the first day of the scheduled week.
- C&D must be in a pile no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 8ft.
- C&D, Metals, and Bulky Items must be in separate piles.

Collection Reminders

- All materials must be placed for collection by **6:30 a.m.** and within 3m of the curb.
- One bulky garbage item (furniture) may be placed for collection per garbage collection.
- Garbage bag limit: 4 bags per collection. Recycling bag limit: no residential limit.
- Garbage must be placed in clear non-colored bags.
- One privacy bag no larger than 20" by 22" per clear garbage bag is permitted.
- Recyclables: clear non-colored or transparent blue bags.
- Organics can be placed in compostable or paper bags.
- Select electronics (computers, televisions, etc.) must be taken to an EPRA drop-off centre - free of charge. Call 1-877-462-8907 for more information.
- Unwanted batteries and cellphones can be taken to the Scalehouse in Little Forks or the Canadian Tire Customer Service Desk.
- Garbage & recyclables cannot be stored in the green cart.

TRANSFER STATIONS

Acceptable Waste: Scrap Metal, Leaf & Yard Waste, Clean Wood, Shingles, Construction & Demolition Debris.

Reminders

- Doors must be removed from fridges and freezers.
- No loads larger than a pickup truck.
- All loads must be secure.
