Pugwash Report

Pugwash has had direct committee representation in the plan. It is included in the engagement process. We expect there will include more specifics for the Village and the rest of the Municipality over time. Where the Village is also part of the Municipality, this Plan from the latter intrinsically includes a plan of the former.

The Plan is to be updated within the next three years and sooner if warranted.

Future updates will include identifying specific Pugwash owned properties that are either compliant or require modification or replacement. Audits will be an ongoing process.

The Village owns several properties buildings and is responsible for sidewalk maintenance.

Built properties

- Pugwash Village Hall
- Pugwash Harbourfront Centre
- Pugwash Train Station
- Public Works Building (the old fire hall)
- (Pugwash Farmers Market?)

Recreational properties/Public access

- Eaton Park
- Basketball/tennis courts
- Volleyball court
- Playground at Eaton Park
- Seawall along Eaton Park and Municipal car park

Utilitarian

- Carpark (waterfront)
- Salt Mine haulage road
- Community Garden

- Sidewalks
- Cenotaph
- Irishtown Road (vacant)

Complete audits of built structures and other public access areas under the ownership or jurisdiction of the Village of Pugwash and identify areas that:

- meet standards;
- currently meet standards but require upgrades or replacement;
- do not meet standards.
