Special Collection Schedule

Regular Collection Day	Special Collection
Monday	→ June 13 th
Tuesday	→ June 20 th
Wednesday	→ June 27 th
Thursday	→ July 4 th
Friday	→ July 11 th

What's Accepted?

Pile 1. Metals: refrigerators, freezers, washers, etc.

Pile 2. Bulky items: furniture, mattresses, etc.

Pile 3. Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D): doors, siding, carpet, & lumber, etc.

NO branches or leaf & yard waste will be collected.

REMINDERS

- All materials must be placed for collection by **6:30 a.m. on Monday of your scheduled week.**
- C&D, metals, & bulky items must be in **3 separate piles.**
- C&D must be in a pile no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 8ft.

Collection Reminders

- All materials must be placed for collection by **6:30 a.m.** and within 3m of the curb.
- One bulky garbage item (mattress & box spring, etc.) can be placed for collection per garbage collection.
- Garbage bag limit: **4 bags per collection.**
Recycling bag limit: **no residential limit.**
- One privacy bag no larger than 20" by 22" per clear garbage bag is permitted.
- **Garbage:** must be placed in clear non-coloured bags.
- **Recyclables:** clear non-coloured or transparent blue bags.
- **Organics:** paper and/or compostable bags can be used in your cart. Leaf and yard waste will only be collected in the cart. **NO PLASTIC**
- Select electronics (computers, televisions, etc.) must be taken to an EPRA drop-off centre - free of charge. Call 1-877-462-8907 for more information.
- Garbage & recyclables cannot be stored in the green cart.
- Pet waste and kitty litter can be placed in your green cart.

TRANSFER STATIONS

Acceptable Waste: Scrap Metal, Leaf & Yard Waste, Clean Wood, Shingles, Construction & Demolition Debris.

Reminders

- No commercial waste.
- Oil tanks must be cut in half.
- Doors must be removed from fridges and freezers.
- No loads larger than a pickup truck.
- All loads must be secure.
