

Pugwash Ground Search and Rescue

The Pugwash Ground Search and Rescue (PGSAR) is a volunteer group working under the Emergency Measures Organization (EMO). The Team assist's local, municipal and provincial authorities during emergencies and at times is asked to provide support to other teams in the province. The Team owns a mobile command post for assignments that are of long duration or complicated.

In the Province of Nova Scotia the Search Teams have a Training Standard to follow so that all searchers are qualified at the same levels. We train our searchers in Map and Compass; First Aid and CPR; GPS units and Radio Communications.

The Team was formed in 1978. In 1988 the members financed and built the PGSAR building in the Village of Pugwash and are used for meetings, training and events. To date, there are 26 volunteered members who dedicate time and knowledge to this organization and continue to train.
