**Recycling:** no limit on residential recycling. Clear, non-coloured bags or transparent, blue bags. Paper products must be separate from recyclable containers. Please rinse containers prior to recycling.

**Garbage:** maximum four, clear, non-coloured bags. One privacy bag (20" x 22") per clear bag is permitted.

**Bulky Items:** 1 bulky garbage item (sofa, chair, boxspring & mattress) can be placed out for collection per garbage pickup. This does not include metal items.

**Organics:** compostable materials only.

### \*\*IMPORTANT COLLECTION NOTICE\*\*

Changes are coming to how solid waste is collected in the Municipality of Cumberland. Effective November 4, 2024, Miller Waste will collect garbage, dual stream recyclables, and organics on the same day, once every two weeks. Due to these changes, residents may see a change to their collection day. A collection map outlining the collection zones will be circulated to residents later in the year.

# Special Collection Schedule

Regular collection day	Special collection day
Wednesday	→ May 6
Thursday	→ May 13
Friday	→ May 27
Monday	→ June 3
Tuesday	→ June 10

## Reminders

- All materials must be placed for collection by 7:00 a.m. on **Monday** of your scheduled week.
- C&D, metals, & bulky items must be in **3 separate piles**. C&D must be in a pile, no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 8ft.
- Leaf & yard waste will not be collected during special collection.
- Do not place items out more than 3 days before your scheduled collection.

### Pile 1. Metals

Refrigerator, freezer, washer & dryer, stove, barbeque, etc.

### Pile 2. Bulky Garbage Items

Furniture, mattress, box spring, chair, sofa, table, desk, **pressure treated lumber (bundled)**, etc.

### Pile 3. Construction & Demolition Debris

Doors, windows, siding, toilet, drywall, shingles, **No pressure treated lumber.**  
**Shingles & insulation must be bagged.**



## Leaf & Yard Waste Collection— May 6, 2024

Branches must be tied in a bundle that does not exceed 1.5m in length or 25kgs in weight. Individual branches must not exceed 5cm in diameter. Materials placed in plastic bags will **NOT** be collected. **Material must be placed for collection by 7:00 a.m. on Monday of the collection week.**
